

His professional background includes over 30 years of experience in UK naval safety and survivability, where he has played a key role in developing the UK's maritime survivability strategy, combat safety, and naval mission modularity. He has also supported survivability advancements through participation in a wide range of international research groups and defence forums.

David is a Fellow of the Royal Institution of Naval Architects and holds the rank of Constructor Captain in the Royal Corps of Naval Constructors.
